GROUPS

Membership of these groups is open to members of the Society only. Members may attend any group meeting but running expenses may be levied as appropriate. Further particulars may be obtained from the Group Secretaries.

Creative Digital Group: Meets on Monday for talks on a wide range of topics, workshops, group activities and competitions (Group annual fee $\pounds 10$). We welcome photographers at all levels of experience. See our page on the EPS website for more information. The following trophies are awarded:

- Advanced Cup Best League 1 performance; Intermediate Cup Best League 2 performance; Gwyer Shield best New Member performance.
- Digital Challenge Cup for an image that demonstrates post-capture editing.

• Cunningham Cup for three images on a theme of the author's choice. Submission to group competitions and workshops is by e-mail to cdgroup@edinburghphotographicsociety.co.uk.

Nature Group: Monthly meetings cover both the technical and aesthetic aspects of photographing nature. Beginners and experienced practitioners are equally welcome. An Exhibition of prints by members is held in February. Field outings will be announced during the season. The 'An Iolaire' cup is awarded for the best set of three images on a theme of the photographer's choice.

DeLOS Outings Group: Organises photography outings around Edinburgh and beyond. A typical outing would involve 2-3 hours photography, after which members usually meet in a café or bar for post-shoot refreshments or a meal. Members are encouraged to add images of outings to the society's Flickr group and these images are mirrored on the EPS website. Membership of this informal group is free, and we welcome all members from the complete novice to the expert. It's a great way to meet fellow photographers and pick up hints and tips to improve your photography. Announcements are usually made via email so please join the EPS mailing list.

Phoenix Group: Provides a forum for constructive criticism and analysis of members' work through mutual discussion. Advice is given on entering national and international exhibitions and on gaining photographic distinctions from e.g. RPS, FIAP and PAGB. It is open to all members of the Society who wish to take their photography to a higher level.

Studio and Portrait Group: Provides something for everyone - from complete beginners to experienced photographers. Organised studio workshops last two hours and are split into two groupings. Beginners are encouraged to attend the theory segment presented in the library while advanced photographers can immediately start working with the invited model. Beginners then join the main group to get practical experience of the topics covered and to improve their portrait photography skills. Classes cover a wide variety of topics. There are plenty of friendly

experts on hand to help answer queries and provide assistance.

The only cost involved is a small charge for model hire on the night (no more than $\pounds 4$ per person).

Members are also encouraged to share images from the various sessions with the group.

Additional special events may also be organised throughout the year and these would be paid for by those attending.

FACILITIES AND ACTIVITIES

MEETINGS: From September to April meetings are held every WEDNESDAY at 7:30 p.m. These include lectures on all aspects of photography, practical demonstrations, competitions etc. Special interest groups meet on other nights of the week (see under **Groups** above).

BEGINNERS: Special instruction workshops are held each session.

DARKROOM: An excellently equipped darkroom in the basement can be used at any time of day or night by members who have paid the Darkroom Fee (see Annual Subscriptions). Enlargers from 35mm to 5" x 7" are available for monochrome work.

LOCKERS: are available in the basement for individual storage of equipment.

DIGITAL FACILITIES: are available on a self-use-basis and consist of a computer, flat bed scanner, slide scanner, and Photoshop software.

LENDING LIBRARY: A library of photographic books from which members may borrow is open by request to any Council member. Members of the public, on payment of a suitable deposit, may also borrow books. Historical books may only be consulted on the premises. The Society also subscribes to most of the leading photographic magazines. Again these can only be read on the premises.

BULLETIN: The bulletin is sent out by email (paper copy by request) three times per year to every member. It contains news of past and future events.

STUDIO: A studio is available for the use of members who have paid the Studio Fee (see Annual Subscriptions). It is equipped with studio flash, backdrops etc. for portraiture. This studio must be booked in advance, and requires training for correct use. Once training has been satisfactorily completed, members are given access to the studio via the security key fob system and the online booking system, subject to the following rules:

- The studio may be booked for up to 3 hours, and only once per day.
- No more than 3 advance bookings may be made, of which only one may be at a weekend.
- There should be a gap of 30 minutes either side of your booking.
- · The studio must be left clean and tidy.
- The studio must NOT be used for professional photography or commercial work; this is deemed to be receiving a fee or making a sale. This could jeopardise our charitable status.

Users who fail to comply with these rules may be banned.

EXHIBITIONS: The Society holds an Annual Members' Exhibition in March. This is the culmination of work by members over the year, and awards are made for outstanding work in various categories. It is open to the public for one weekend.

The Society organises the world famous Edinburgh International Exhibition of Photography which takes place for four weeks each August. It has been running for over 150 years.

An informal exhibition of Members' work is held each November in the Fine Art Library on George IV Bridge.

There is a small Basement Gallery which is available for one man shows and collections of prints from other Societies. Any member who wishes to use the Gallery for an exhibition should contact Sandy Cleland.

The financial year commences on 1st September. New Ordinary Members joining on or after 1st January shall pay a half subscription for the year then current. This does not apply to members who are renewing their membership; they must pay the full fee. Darkroom, Studio, and Locker fees must always be paid in full. Junior members are not permitted to use the Darkroom, Digital Facilities or Studio except on occasions with special permission. Life members are entitled to use the Darkroom, Studio and Digital Facilities. They are responsible for paying any locker rental, key deposits or Group membership fees. Student members must be able to show proof of being in full-time attendance at a recognised educational establishment.

CHANGES to PERSONAL DETAILS: All members of the Society must inform the Membership Secretary immediately when they change address, telephone numbers or email addresses otherwise bulletins, copies of the syllabus and membership renewal forms are likely to go astray. Applicants for membership who are likely to be changing their address should give a fixed address. For example, students should give a University Union address rather than digs.

KEYS: A personalised key fob for access to the main door, studio, and darkroom will be issued to each member on payment of the relevant fees.

MONTHLY COMPETITIONS Prints and Projected Images

Members are encouraged to submit entries for these Competitions which are held from November to March. The subject is open i.e. one may enter pictorial, record, nature or scientific photographs. Print and projected image entries will be marked out of 20 and will be commented on by the Judge on Competition Night. Two entries may be submitted to each competition

The four Print and four Projected Image Monthly Competitions are separate and alternate at approximately two week intervals. There are two leagues for both competitions. On each competition night the judge will also nominate the best overall image of the evening, regardless of league.

Awards and Trophies: At the end of the season Trophies will be awarded in each League based on each member's 5 best scores. In the event of a tie, the best six scores will be used, and so on.

The following trophies are presented at the AGM of the Society.

SECTIONS AND PROMOTION RULES

Members may enter their images in one of two Leagues – League 1 and League 2. This applies separately to print and projected image competitions, and to the Members' Exhibition. The following are guidelines for selecting the appropriate League in which to enter images.

League 1 Members who hold any level of distinction from any recognised awarding body, such as the RPS, PAGB, FIAP or BPE must enter this section.

League 2 Members who do not hold any such distinctions may enter League 2.

Members unsure of which League to enter should consult a member of the Advisory Panel (see "Other useful contacts" near the start of this booklet). The Advisory Panel may suggest that a member should enter images into League 1, based on an appraisal of the member's work, in spite of the member holding no photographic distinction. In addition any member may submit work to the Panel at any time for assessment with a view to promotion to a higher section. The Panel will also consider entries in the Members' Exhibition and promote any member whose work warrants it.

Methods of Promotion: Normally, promotion from League 2 to League 1 is decided on the basis of performance in the Monthly Competitions. Members whose five highest marks total or exceed 87 will be promoted to League 1. These totals are determined separately for Prints and Projected Images.

SUBMISSION DETAILS

PRINTS

- Identification All prints must bear a title, the member's Number (not name) and League.
- Mounting All prints must be mounted on board, either flushmounted or window-mounted. No adhesive or Velcrotype patches should be attached as these may damage other members' prints.
- **Print Size** No print including mount may exceed 50 cm x 40 cm.
- Digital Files For each print submitted a member must also submit a digital file at normal projection resolution (see "Digital Images" section) by email to epsprints@edinburghphotographicsociety.co.uk These files will only be kept as a digital record of prints submitted for the Monthly Print Competitions. The judges will have no access to these files. Those members producing prints by non-digital processes should contact the Print Competition Secretary to arrange for their prints to be scanned.
- **Processing** In both Leagues processing by a third party is acceptable, but this must be noted on the back of the print, otherwise all work submitted must be completely the work of the author.

All prints must be placed on the appropriate shelf in the Library on or before the competition hand-in date. Members should take care of their own and other members' prints when doing so. Any prints which are not collected by Members on competition nights, or are retained for display, will be replaced on the shelves in the Library for collection as soon as possible. The Society reserves the right to dispose of prints which have not been collected within two months

At the end of the competition evenings, as many prints as possible will be placed on the display boards at the front of the meeting room to allow close inspection. In addition, a selection of high-scoring prints will be displayed in the lobby of EPS premises, until the next print competition. Members who do not wish their prints to be so displayed should inform the Print Competition Secretary.

DIGITAL IMAGES

MUST be .jpg **(JPEG)**, and should be 1920 pixels (maximum) horizontally x 1200 pixels (maximum) vertically. It is recommended that you use the sRGB profile. Please do not submit images larger than this. Images should be submitted by email to

comps@edinburghphotographicsociety.co.uk.

File names should follow the following convention: XX_nnnn_Image name.jpg where XX=L1 or L2 (League 1 or League 2) and nnnn is your four digit membership number. Your image name may contain spaces and should be capitalised as appropriate. Please note that underscores are used to separate the components of the file name and should not be used within your image name. Full submission guidelines are on the EPS web-site under "Competition Guidelines".

NOTES

It is a condition of entry into both competitions that, unless otherwise stated in writing, prints and projected images entered for any society competitions, or the Members' Exhibition, may be used for any Inter-club or national competition in which the Society takes part or on the society's website.

All images, and/or the constituent parts of an image, must be the original work of the author.

No prints or projected images may be entered which have been shown previously in a Members' Exhibition.
